We offer a private family viewing prior to public visitation at no additional charge. We request that you come in and acclimate yourself to the surroundings making sure that everything is as you want it before receiving guests for public visitation. We allow up to an hour for this service.

When selecting your hours of visitation, visitation it is always tailored to your family's needs. We will always work to accommodate your requests.

*We offer the choice of having background music during visitation at no additional charge. We feel that music goes a long way to complementing the visitation, especially when it is a reflection of whom the service is for. ****New**** create your playlist own your Apple Music or Spotify account and pair it with our system to make your visitation or reception more meaningful.*

We have several televisions for showing media presentations whether it be for picture presentations. There will be no charge for their use.

Co-ordination of Activities, Rites and Ceremonies

For co-ordination of Funeral Arrangements, we offer the services of a licensed funeral director to consult with family members regarding their personal choices and options available for funeral, memorial or direct disposition arrangements. This may include the coordinating of the initial transfer from the place of death, obtaining vital statistics, scheduling with clergy, musicians, cemetery and / or crematorium, reception facilitator, coroner and other necessary contacts, preparing and placing death notices. The overseeing of all other staff functions necessary to implement the arrangements such as clerical and accounting support, 24 hour phone answering, receptionists, parking lot attendants and custodial staff. Also this allows for McCormack's bereavement support programs and Family After Service Care consultation.

Initial Transfer

\$195.00

We will transfer from the place of death (Hospital, Residence, Nursing Home or Hospice) to McCormack Funeral Home, within a 20 km radius of the funeral home. This service is available on a 24 hour basis and includes our Funeral Coach, staff, mortuary equipment and sundries. Additional mileage charges beyond the 20 km radius may apply at \$1.90 per km, one way.

Documentation

\$240.00

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation, documentation necessary to ship the body out of the country and the provision of Proof of Death Certificates issued by McCormack Funeral Home - Stewart Chapel. Disclaimer - our Proof of Death Certificates are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a provincial "Certified Death Certificate" will be necessary and is available from the Office of the Registrar General. Application completion if required can be done at no additional charge. Information pertaining to the arrangements is maintained on file at McCormack Funeral Home - Stewart Chapel, available for future reference.

Basic Preparation

(Requires Facilities for Preparation and Sheltering of Remains)

Basic preparation may include but not limited to the visual inspection of the body, disinfection and bathing of the remains, positioning of the facial features, dressing as required and placement in a casket or cremation container for identification or viewing.

Facilities for Preparation and Sheltering of Remains

A designated area is provided for sheltering of the remains until the visitation, funeral service or transfer to the crematorium or cemetery.

Professional Preparation - "Embalming"

\$395.00

(Requires Basic Preparation and Facilities for Preparation and Sheltering of Remains) Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required, but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation, identification viewing or disposition of the deceased. McCormack Funeral Home - Stewart Chapel funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected service needs.

Staffing for Visitation

\$200.00 / Hr.

Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation, as a traditional visitation with casket present or for a memorial visitation (no casket present) for a period of one hour per number of hours selected.

Facilities for Visitation

\$125.00 / Hr.

(Requires Staffing for Visitation)

Designated facilities used for visitation for a period of one hour per number of hours selected.

NOTE TO READER - Facilities for Visitation are charged for hours that are publicly announced. The family may arrive up to one hour ahead of public visitation to acclimatize themselves before receiving guests, at no additional charge.

Staff to coordinate and oversee the ceremony or memorial service either at McCormack Funeral Home or a church or venue or your choice for up to 4 hours.

Facilities for Ceremony or Set Up Offsite

\$400.00

(Requires Staff Services for Ceremony)

Designated facilities and equipment used for the ceremony or memorial service for up to 3 hours when located at McCormack Funeral Home. Or, the provision of necessary equipment to provide services when at a church or venue offsite is used for services for a period of up to 3 hours

Funeral Coach

\$425.00

The use of this specialized vehicle is for the transportation of the casket or cremation container from McCormack Funeral Home or church as required following through to the cemetery and / or crematorium. Rental of the funeral coach is for a three hour period and within a 20 km radius of McCormack Funeral Home.

Lead Vehicle

Disbursements are items arranged for and paid for on your behalf by McCormack Funeral Home. Should a down payment towards funeral expenses be requested it is usually to include these items as there are an immediate expense incurred by the funeral home.

The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements.

Coroner's Fee - this is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario. Fee \$75.00

Clergy Honorarium - this is an amount paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases the amount is set by the clergy, in others it is an amount to be determined by you. Estimate \$100 - \$350

Organist Fee - this is an amount paid to an organist to play either at McCormack Funeral Home or a local church. Estimate \$100 - \$200

Bagpiper - To have a bagpiper play at service and/or graveside. Estimate \$200 +

Newspaper Notices - these are charges for obituary notices placed in local newspapers or other media outlets. Charges will be billed at cost. Estimate \$200 average..

CEMETERY DISBURSEMENTS

For items such as cremation, lot purchases (burial or cremation), opening and closing fees, niches, canopies, mausoleum purchases and entombment fees and overtime charges, please call your local cemetery to find out more on the services they offer.
